  - Lunchtimes are sometimes boring – monitor Happy Lunchtimes
  - Table Tennis – it is so busy and not everyone gets a go. Mrs Perrett to speak to Mrs Blythe and monitor it.
  - Skipping ropes getting tangled – Mrs Perrett to speak to children in assembly
